By 2015 all healthcare providers will be required to have electronic health records (EHR). The work required to reach this goal is expected to create a high demand for several types of health information technology (HIT) professionals.

Dyersburg State is offering training for three HI-TECH workforce roles:

- Clinician/Practitioner Consultant
- Trainer
- Practice Workflow and Information Redesign Specialist

Admission Requirements

- Qualified applicants must meet pre-assessment criteria
- Experience is preferred in either Healthcare or Information Technology
- Must be able to work in the United States

Required Documents

- HITECH Application
- College Transcript (if applicable)
- Resume
- Verifiable Employment Letter(s) from employer(s) with contact information, job description and employment date.
- Applications will be reviewed on a case-by-case basis. Applicants will be notified via email.

Cost - \$200 per workforce role

\$150 will be refunded if the student successfully completes the program within six months.

A certificate of continuing education is earned for the HI-TECH workforce roles successfully completed in six months. Pre-Assessment and Competency Exams are required.

Sign-up deadline - September 30.
